During the March 11, 2010 Southern Nevada Chapter, International Code Council meeting, our members agreed to sponsor one (1) voting representative from each of our paid Governmental Jurisdictional members (six total) to attend the ICC Final Action Hearings in Dallas, Texas concerning the proposed code changes for the 2012 editions of the I-Codes.

The SN-ICC Chapter has also requested each of the SNBO Technical Code Committees (IBC-Structural, IBC-General, IBC-Fire & Life Safety and IRC) to review the proposed ICC code changes and associated public comments (to be posted this week). Each of the SNBO Technical Code Committees will create a consensus voting document to be used during the final action code hearings.

All attendees sponsored by the SN-ICC Chapter, will be required to vote in accordance with the SNBO Technical Code Committee's recommendations.

The Chapter will reimburse each designated voting representative for round-trip air fare, lodging (\$115/night, 8 nights max) and meals (maximum \$60/day).
