



2019 SN-ICC ETHICS POLICY

This code of Ethics is the policy of the SN-ICC and expresses fundamental values. Accordingly, this Policy guides the conduct of all Chapter members, and is intended to foster an environment that promotes ethical conduct in carrying out their responsibilities as volunteers within the organization.

Professional Excellence

SN-ICC promotes professional excellence and encourages open and honest communication among all members.

Accountability

The Chapter has responsibilities to conduct its business in a transparent and accountable manner, ensuring honest, accountable methods. Spend Chapter money in accordance with the membership approved budget and in a fiduciary manner while making full and fair disclosures of all relevant information.

Conflict of Interest

Avoid the perception of wrongdoing and appearance of a conflict of interest.

Fundraising

Chapter members shall not solicit monies and/or sponsorships for any SNICC activities from any industry so regulated by individual Chapter members.

Confidential Information

Confidentiality is a hallmark of professionalism. Ensure that all information which is confidential or privileged or which is not publicly available is not disclosed inappropriately.

Perceived Breaches

Chapter members are encouraged to disclose any perceived breaches of the Ethics Policy. Disclosure should be made to a member of the Ethics Committee or the Board of Directors.
