WHO SHOULD APPLY

Southern Nevada high school graduates with a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA or college/university students in Southern Nevada with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA who plan to pursue a career in architecture, engineering, construction management or public administration may apply for this scholarship. The student must attend an accredited post-secondary college or university. Preference will be given to Southern Nevada high school and college students.

AWARD

Four scholarships in the amount of \$3,000 will be awarded. Verification of enrollment (class schedule) is required. Scholarship funds may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or other appropriate educational expenses. These funds will be disbursed in equal payments over two semesters.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications must be received by the Public Education Foundation or postmarked by the application deadline.
