



# SNICC SCHOLARSHIPS

**The Southern Nevada Chapter of the International Code Council (SNICC)** has partnered with the *Public Education Foundation* to provide scholarships for Southern Nevada high school, undergraduate college and university students wishing to pursue higher-education degrees at a **Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE)** institution in the fields of **Architecture, Engineering, Construction Management and Public Administration**. (*Qualified engineering studies are limited to the following degree programs: Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Geotechnical, Environmental and Land Surveying.*)

Scholarships are currently available in the following categories:

## High School Students

**Southern Nevada High School Seniors** with a min. 3.0 GPA intending to pursue degrees in: **Architecture, Engineering, Construction Management or Public Administration** at a NSHE institution. Preference will be given to students attending institutions in Southern rather than Northern Nevada. Multiple scholarships between \$1,000 to \$3,000 each will be distributed this year.

## Undergraduate College Students

Current Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors with a min. 3.0 GPA intending to pursue degrees in: **Architecture, Engineering, Construction Management or Public Administration** at an NSHE institution. Preference will be given to students attending institutions in Southern rather than Northern Nevada. Multiple scholarships between \$1,000 to \$8,000 each will be distributed this year.

## Graduate Students

Graduate Students with a **qualified undergraduate degree pursuing a Master's or Doctorate degree in: Architecture, Engineering, Construction Management or Public Administration** at a NSHE institution. Preference will be given to students attending institutions in Southern rather than Northern Nevada. Multiple scholarships between \$3,000 to \$5,000 each will be distributed this year.

**Note:** *Verification of college enrollment (formally issued by participating institution) is required to be submitted prior to funds being awarded. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to only a NSHE institution and must be applied toward tuition, fees and other educational expenses. Per PEF regulations, individual scholarship funds will be disbursed in equal payments over two (2) consecutive semesters.*
